WHAT IS A DAY CENTRE?

A day centre is a supportive, safe environment where older adults, individuals with dementia, or those needing special support. Day centres offer a structured setting with access to professional care, social interaction, and a variety of activities designed to enhance quality of life. They also provide valuable respite for caregivers, ensuring that their loved ones receive compassionate, tailored support in a secure community setting.

WHY CHOOSE US?

- Professional Care Team: Our compassionate and highly trained team provides personalised attention, support, and care to meet individual needs.
- Full-Day Facility Access: Open Monday through Friday, from 9:00 am to 4:00 pm, members can attend as little as once per week or all five days, offering flexible options to fit their routines.
- Two-Course Nutritious Meal: Prepared daily, members enjoy a delicious, balanced two-course meal in addition to unlimited refreshments, ensuring they are nourished and hydrated throughout the day.
- Cost-effective: Starting from just £47 per person, per day (less than £6.72 per hour) our Day Centre is a low cost option when considering care options.

- Emotional & Psychological Support: Our staff are trained not only in practical care but also in providing emotional support, helping members feel valued, respected, and heard.

HOW TO REFER TO US:

Our referral process is straightforward, and we offer flexibility to suit individual needs. Whether clients require a short-term placement—just a few days or weeks—or are seeking a more permanent arrangement, our team is ready to assist in making the transition seamless.

Step 1: Book a Trial Visit

To ensure our centre is the perfect fit, we highly recommend a trial visit. This allows potential members and their families to meet our team, explore the facilities, and experience a typical day. During this visit, we can address any questions and further discuss how we'll support the individual's unique needs.


Step 2: Complete a Support Plan

We ask that family members or professionals complete a support plan for each individual. This document allows us to understand the specific needs, preferences, and goals of the member, ensuring a personalised experience. Alongside the support plan, families and professionals will receive our Terms and Conditions. These can be reviewed at any time on our website.

Step 3: Confirm Start Date

Once the support plan is completed and the trial visit is successful, we can typically have someone start within a week. We're committed to making the transition as smooth as possible and will coordinate with families or professionals to ensure all preparations are in place.

1. Do you provide transport to and from the day centre?

No, we currently don't offer direct transport. However, we recommend using Keep Mobile at 0345 544 0850 or The ARC Trust Transport at 01344 266911 for convenient travel options.

2. Can you help with medication management?

Yes, we can assist with certain types of medication. Please contact us directly to discuss specific requirements, as there are some limitations on the types of medication we can support.

3. Are you able to support with toileting needs?

We provide assistance with some elements of toileting support. Please reach out to us so we can discuss specific needs and determine the best support plan.

4. What food options are available?

Our centre offers a diverse menu, with a range of delicious and nutritious meals. If a particular dish isn't to someone's taste, we have alternative options available, including vegetarian and vegan choices.

5. How is payment handled?

For private payers, payment is typically made a month in advance. For those funded by the local authority, we follow an established payment process already in place to ensure smooth transactions.

6. What if someone only needs short-term care?

We're flexible with placements and can accommodate short-term stays, whether a few days or several weeks. Please contact us to discuss these arrangements.
